Dedibox: a dedicated hosting service for 29.99 euros excluding VAT per month

In line with its strategy of allowing consumers to benefit from the best possible services at the best possible price, the Iliad group is pleased to announce the launch of its Dedibox service, its first dedicated hosting service available to all.

Dedicated server hosting services were previously the sole preserve of business customers, due to their prohibitive cost, but they are now accessible to private individuals as well, thanks to the Dedibox, which is available at a very reasonable price.

Customers will pay a flat rate charge of €29.99 excluding VAT per month, without any minimum contract period and with no installation charge, for this dedicated hosting service, which includes:

- a 160 GB SATA hard disk
- a 2 GHz processor,
- 1 GB of DDR2 RAM,
- 100 Mbit/s connectivity,
- a remote monitoring and reboot service.

This new service offers users numerous different applications, such as website hosting, games servers, multimedia streaming, as well as remote hard disk and file sharing. Dedibox also allows the use of remote applications, taking full advantage of the convergence between broadband access and content.

This innovative new dedicated server platform is the result of several months of research and development work. The Dedibox servers have been created in collaboration with VIA Technologies and use a new generation 2 GHz processor with very low power consumption.

The servers are housed in one of the group's extremely secure data centres (generators, UPS, biometric access control, etc.) where the very latest technologies are used to provide redundancy and so guarantee continuity of service.

This new service has been created with a view to making a wider choice of hosting services available and to allow Internet users to access a far wider range of content.
