Unlimited calls to landline numbers in Guadeloupe and Martinique included in the Freebox package

11 other new international destinations also added to the package

Having been a major force in the push to drive down the cost of international calls, and true to its promise of always providing an ever-wider range of services at the most competitive prices, Free has further enhanced its Freebox telephony service offering by including in the price of the package (29.99 euros per month) unlimited calls 24 hours a day, seven days a week to landline numbers in **Guadeloupe** and **Martinique** as well as to a further 11 international destinations:

These new destinations are in addition to the fifteen¹ already included in the package (France, United Kingdom, USA, China, etc.).

Free, the only Internet service providers whose capital is still largely in the hands of French shareholders, is the first broadband operator to offer unlimited telephone calls to the French overseas dependencies.

Free is helping to bridge the digital divide between mainland France and its overseas dependencies, and consumers will now be able to telephone friends and family whether they are located in France or overseas in Guadeloupe or Martinique.

Until this new offer, French telephone users were subject to high tariffs when calling the French dependencies. For example, a daily 5-minute call in standard peak rate to Guadeloupe or Martinique from a France Telecom fixed line costs €39 incl. VAT over a 30 day period.²

This offer is available to all Freebox subscribers whether or not they are connected by means of an unbundled line (full or partial) and whatever type of Freebox they are using.

Service available from 1 July 2006 and subject to eligibility of the telephone line and acceptance of the general terms and conditions of sale on line.

The Freebox offer is available in mainland France subject to suitability of the subscriber's telephone line.

Excludes calls to short numbers and special numbers.

Free is a subsidiary of the Iliad Group. The Iliad Group is a major player in the Internet and telecommunications markets in France through its subsidiaries Free (the leading alternative broadband operator with 1,783,000 broadband subscribers as at 31/03/2006), One.Tel and Iliad Telecom (fixed telephony operators) and Kertel (prepaid phone cards), as well as IFW (wireless local loop). The Iliad Group was established in 1991 and currently has more than 1,000 employees. The Iliad Group is listed on the Euronext Paris Eurolist under the mnemonic code ILD.
