All eight League Cup quarter-final matches to be shown simultaneously, only on Free's broadband TV service

On 20 September 2006 all eight matches of the League Cup quarter finals are going to be broadcast live and simultaneously on Free TV, free of charge.

For the third year running, and in partnership with France Télévisions, Free is offering its subscribers the chance to watch all eight League Cup quarter-final matches, brought live and in their entirety – at no extra charge – to their televisions.

Thanks to the special “A match for each region” broadcast¹, viewers can choose whatever match or matches they want to watch out of the eight being broadcast from the broadcaster's regional transmitters.

As from 9 p.m. this coming 20 September, viewers can go to a multiscreen format channel showing thumbnails and information about the eight matches being shown² and access a “goal by goal” service giving the live score for each of the various matches in progress.

The eight matches to be shown on Freebox TV will be:

- Valenciennes versus Monaco
- Montpellier versus Marseille
- Rennes versus Libourne
- Sète versus Saint-Étienne
- Auxerre versus Strasbourg
- Sedan versus Sochaux
- PSG versus Lorient
- Troyes versus Le Mans

Free is a subsidiary of Iliad.
