**TF1, TMC, Tfoi and Odyssee available on Freebox TV as of 5<sup>th</sup> January 2007**  
**TF1 Vision reinforces Free's VOD offer**

After launching access to Jet TV and TMC in December, the channels of the TF1 Group are arriving in force on Freebox TV. As of 5<sup>th</sup> January 2007, TF1, Tfoi and Odyssee will be available to all subscribers who are eligible for the Free audiovisual service, no matter what version of the Freebox they have.

Furthermore, Free confirms its progress in Video on Demand (VOD): indeed, it will be launching access to TF1 Vision, TF1 Group's on demand TV channel, at the same time as the above channels, thus enabling subscribers to view already broadcasted programmes again and again whenever they want.

With several hundred exclusive programmes available on launch, the wide choice of TF1 Vision's catalogue will be accessible to Freebox subscribers: films, dramas, serials, entertainment, young peoples' and discovery programmes. The subscribers will also have the possibility of free choice viewing of the most successful television shows broadcast directly to their own TV.

This VOD offer gives the subscribers a great deal of flexibility and freedom in viewing audiovisual programmes on Freebox. The programmes are available to all of the subscribers who are eligible for Free's audiovisual service, no matter what version of the Freebox they have.

TF1 Vision enables Free to reinforce its offer of programmes on demand available on the Freebox. Thanks to this agreement, Free confirms its technological progress, in being the only platform on ADSL to offer its subscribers such a wide and comprehensive video-on-demand offer.
