Mr. Tadjbakhsh has served on Iliad's Board since March, 2003. Iliad wishes to thank him for his continuous and effective contribution over the years.

Iliad has immediately undertaken a search for a new independent board member.

The Iliad Group is a dominant player in the French Internet access and telecommunications market with Free (largest alternative operator with 2,076,000 ADSL subscribers on 30/09/2006), Onetel and Iliad Télécom (fixed telephony operators), Kertel (prepaid cards), IFW (Wimax) and Citefibre (FTTH). The Iliad Group was created in 1991 and today employs more than 1,500 people. The Iliad Group is quoted on the Eurolist-Euronext Paris under the symbol ILD.
