Jean Louis Missika appointed Vice Chairman of Iliad's Board of Directors

Jean Louis Missika was appointed Vice Chairman of Iliad's Board of Directors on 18 December 2006. He took up his position on 8 January 2007. Jean Louis Missika will oversee institutional relations with the goal of giving elected officials and local authorities a better understanding of the group's strategy. He will also coordinate media relations so as to strengthen the expansion of Free's audiovisual services. Jean Louis Missika will also be in charge of relations with research and audience rating firms.

A member of Iliad's Board of Directors since 28 June 2004, Jean-Louis Missika is the founder and former Chairman and CEO of JLM Conseil, an affiliate of the Altedia group. He has previously been CEO of BVA, deputy CEO of Sofres and editor-in-chief of the journal *Médiaspouvoirs*.

Between 1988 and 1991, Jean Louis Missika was director of the French Prime Minister Michel Rocard's information department.

He recently published *La fin de la télévision* (Seuil Publishing) and is co-author of *La folle du logis, la télévision dans les sociétés démocratiques* (Gallimard Publishing) and several other books, including *Raymond Aron, le spectateur engagé* (Julliard, 1981) and *Jean-Marie Lustiger, le choix de Dieu* (Bernard de Fallois, 1987). He has also written television documentary programmes.

Jean-Louis Missika teaches sociology of the media at Sciences Po Paris.

The Iliad Group is a dominant player on the French Internet access and telecommunications market with Free (leading alternative ADSL operator with 2,076,000 ADSL subscribers at 30/09/2006), Onetel and Iliad Télécom (landline telephone operators), Kertel (prepaid cards), IFW (Wimax) and Citefibre (FTTH).
