Patrick Fouquière appointed Director of Supplier Relations with the Iliad group

Patrick Fouquière was appointed Iliad's Director of Supplier Relations on 18 December 2006. He took up his position on 8 January 2007. He will be responsible for negotiating and supervising commercial relations with the group's suppliers.

Patrick Fouquière started his career as commercial engineer for Belgacom France (1996), before joining GTS-Omnicom (1998-2000). In 2001, he joined Onetel as head of voice-related purchases and operator relations.

After Onetel was taken over by Iliad in December 2001, Patrick Fouquière took up responsibility for group relations with operators and local authorities for deploying optical fibre infrastructures.

The Iliad Group is a dominant player on the French Internet access and telecommunications market with Free (leading alternative ADSL operator with 2,076,000 ADSL subscribers at 30/09/2006), Onetel and Iliad Télécom (landline telephone operators), Kertel (prepaid cards), IFW (Wimax) and Citefibre (FTTH). Created in 1991, the Iliad Group currently employs over 1,500 people. The Iliad Group is listed on Eurolist by Euronext Paris under the symbol ILD.
