**Reunion, Turkey, Poland, Luxembourg, Russia, Japan, and more**

**Unlimited calls to landline phones in 20 new international destinations and La Réunion included in the Freebox plan (29.99 euros per month)**

After introducing fixed rates for unlimited calling, driving the sharp decrease in international calling rates, Free is further enriching its Freebox telephone offer.

True to its strategy of offering ever more services at the best price, Free making a new addition to its fixed rate plan (29.99 euros/month): 24/7 unlimited calling to landlines in **La Réunion** and in twenty new international destinations. Thanks to this extension, Free now includes **49** destinations in its unlimited calling plan:

These destinations will complement the 28<sup>1</sup> countries already included in the plan (France, UK, US, China, etc.).

Free also offers unlimited telephone service to landlines in the main French Overseas Departments (DOMs): now, La Réunion will join Guadeloupe and Martinique among the destinations included in the plan.

It is worthy of note that until now, consumers were penalised with very high rates for calls to these destinations.

Free is making mainland France a little closer to the DOMs by continually expanding its offer as soon as the conditions allow it, giving a concrete response to consumers' and the public authorities' expectations for national cohesion and coverage. Thanks to Free, distances between the mainland and the DOMs are getting shorter, and consumers can now call their friends and family as often as they want, whether they're in mainland France, La Réunion, Guadeloupe or Martinique.

This offer applies to all Freebox subscribers with partial or total unbundling and to non-unbundled subscribers (IP ADSL or Freebox Only), no matter what type of Freebox they have.
