THE WALT DISNEY COMPANY AND *FREE* CONCLUDE SVOD MOVIE AGREEMENT IN FRANCE

Free and Disney-ABC International Television have concluded a SVOD agreement to bring a wide selection of Disney content to Free Home Video subscribers in France.

With this agreement, Freebox subscribers will be able to enjoy a wide selection of live action films from The Walt Disney Company's extensive portfolio. Blockbusters such as "Armageddon," "Pirates of the Caribbean: The Curse of the Black Pearl," "Signs" and "Gone in 60 Seconds" as well as favourites "Pretty Woman," "Sister Act" and "Dead Poets Society" will be included in the agreement. Younger viewers will be able to enjoy family classics such as "101 Dalmatians," "Mary Poppins" and "Flubber."

Through this agreement, Free is strengthening its VOD position in France. *Free Home Vidéo* was launched in June. This offer provides unlimited access 24/7 to more than 50 films and 100 TV episodes renewed every week, for €5.99 a month.
