TV accessible to all Free internet users

From now on, all Free broadband internet subscribers have access to a package of television channels from Free's portal.

The channels are MPEG4 H264 encoded to ensure the highest possible broadcast quality.

To access these channels, Free broadband internet subscribers need simply go to www.free.fr.

This service is accessible in all bundled or unbundled areas. It is included in the Freebox fixed rate plan.

Offer accessible subject to broadband line eligibility.

Package of channels available: France 2, France 3, France 5, Arte, Direct 8, NT1, NRJ12, LCP, BFM TV, TV5, France Ô, Al Jazeera.
