***As of today, the debate between the final two presidential candidates is available free on Freebox TV VOD***

*Through Freebox TV and TF1 Vision, the TF1 Group's video-on-demand system, Free subscribers can watch the debate for the first time or a repeat viewing, right up until they vote*

Three days before the second round of the presidential election, Freebox TV gives its subscribers a chance to catch-up by watching, for the first time or a repeat viewing, the debate between the final two presidential candidates free on their television.

The debate is available on Freebox channel 1 ("info" button), 24 hours a day until Sunday evening.
