21 new destinations included in the Freebox package

True to its strategy of offering ever more services for the same price (€29.99 per month), Free is extending its unlimited calls to landlines service by including **21 new international destinations**, bringing to **70** the number of destinations included in the Freebox fixed rate plan:

With the Freebox plan, subscribers benefit from a telephone service that includes unlimited calls to other landlines in France including other operators Box landlines.

[In its 2007 report](#)¹ on communication prospects in OECD zone countries, the Organisation pointed out that "one of the most extensive offers of unlimited calling comes from the French competitive operator Free".

This offer applies from October 1st, 2007 to all Freebox subscribers with total unbundling (partially or totally unbundled) or not (IP ADSL or Freebox Only).

To benefit from these new destinations, subscribers simply need to login to their management console (www.free.fr) and agree to the new general conditions of sale (CGV). New subscribers benefit from this offer automatically.

The modifications made to the CGV of 11/07/07 only relate to the pricing section (addition of the 21 new destinations). Beyond October 1st, 2007, the application of the new pricing structure will come into effect within 24 hours from when the new CGV are agreed to.

Freebox is available in mainland France subject to phone line eligibility. Excludes calls to special numbers and mobile phones.
