Telesites:

Free users are now able to broadcast their web site on television !

Free is offering a new service for its subscribers, meaning that Free users can now broadcast their own web sites on television.

This new *Telesite* service, included in the Free broadband package, makes it possible for all Free users to broadcast their web sites directly on the television screen, thanks to their Freebox.

The service is easy to use: after creating their web site, Free subscribers need to declare it in their subscription console, then give it a title and description. They can then decide whether to make their telesite accessible to just themselves (with the telesite available in “*My telesites*”) or make it open to all Free users.

Free is also offering the possibility for all of its users who have created their videos on *TV Perso Freebox* to incorporate them on to their telesite. They will then be able to view them directly from the telesite. In this way, the videos of Free users will be able to benefit from all the visibility of this new service.

The Telesite service can be accessed from the main menu on the Freebox TV interface.
