M6 HD available on Freebox TV

Free is adding "M6 HD" to its selection of high definition (HD) channels. In this way, ADSL subscribers equipped with the Freebox HD will now be able to access this channel's high-definition programs and enjoy all of the various HD content, including matches from Euro 2008, French series and dramas (Prison Break, NCIS, Desperate Housewives, Au secours les enfants reviennent, etc.) filmed in native HD.

The channel is being offered to ADSL subscribers with a Freebox HD at no extra cost as part of their broadband package for 29.99 euros/month. The Freebox HD has been offered to all of Free's new ADSL unbundled subscribers since April 2006.

Offer available subject to the telephone line's eligibility for the Freebox TV service, the speed required and high-definition-compatible accessories and equipment.

Free is a subsidiary of Iliad.
