**Freebox TV first to feature France 24 channels in French, English and Arabic**

Free continues to enrich its TV offering and is the first to provide its subscribers with access to the international news channel France 24, in its two language variations: English and Arabic.

France 24 devotes a channel to each of these languages and will broadcast different programmes on each of them.

Launched in December 2006, France 24 is the 24/7 news channel. Its mission is to cover the news with a French outlook and convey French values and viewpoints the world over.

These new channels will strengthen the relative significance of news in Free's audiovisual offering, which already has about ten news channels.

France 24 is available on channels 24 (French), 95 (English) and 96 (Arabic).
