**Free continues to innovate  
with the launch of remote TV programme recording**

Free has once again enriched its service offering without increasing the price of its package (€29.99 per month).

The digital video recorder integrated in Freebox HDs, which only Free includes in its package since 2006, now features a new function: remote recording.

Free subscribers may now remotely programme their video recorder to record their chosen content.

Programming may be carried out very easily from the account management platform on Free's website, which can be accessed from any internet connection ("Mon Compte" section on [Free's](#) home page).

Several recording options are available:

- Immediate recording: the recorder is set by default to the time the subscriber has opened the session. He/she therefore only has to specify the channel and recording time and validate to start recording.
- Deferred, one-off or periodic recording.
- Recording from the programme guide, with the option of defining channels as favourites that come up by default.

The TV signal may be recorded either in High Definition (HD), Standard Definition (SD) or Low Speed version (MPEG4), depending on the level of definition supported by the various channels.

Subject to line speed, two programmes may be recorded at the same time on a single Freebox HD TV box.

Subscribers may also programme a recording on an external hard drive plugged into the Freebox HD USB port.

Lastly, this service is available for subscribers to the Multi TV<sup>1</sup> package and thus allows them to select the TV set on which the programme must be recorded.
