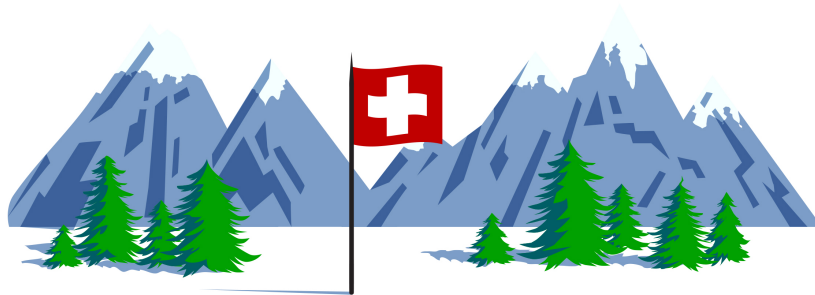

Free Mobile Plan:

25GB/month of mobile Internet from Switzerland included!

The Free Mobile Plan is travelling to

Switzerland



Free mobile plan subscribers (€15.99/month for Freebox subscribers, €19.99/month otherwise) can now communicate from **Switzerland free of charge** by using up **to 25GB/month** of roaming mobile Internet without extra cost.

This mobile Internet allowance is in addition to that available under the Free plan in Metropolitan France.

The Free Mobile Plan roaming offer includes the following, **all year round**:

- **25GB/month** of 3G mobile Internet that can be used in Europe, French overseas departments, the United States, Canada, Israel, Australia, South Africa, New Zealand, Mexico and Switzerland
- **unlimited** calls, texts and MMS in Europe and the French overseas departments (DOM)
- **unlimited** calls, texts and MMS (local and to Metropolitan France) in other countries (*United States, Canada, Israel, Australia, South Africa and New Zealand*)

The Free Mobile Plan still includes unlimited calls/texts/MMS in Metropolitan France, unlimited calls to landlines in 100 destinations, and unlimited 4G+ for Freebox subscribers (100GB/month otherwise).

All Free Mobile Plan subscribers can currently use these 25GB/month of data from Switzerland.
