

## Scaleway launches its Object Storage solution and continues to deploy its cloud ecosystem

Paris, February 8, 2019 – Today, Scaleway has launched a highly relevant European object storage solution that is API S3 compatible. This solution can be used to easily manage petabytes of high-speed data while offering excellent levels of scalability, availability and security.



As from today, users can access the object storage solution designed by Scaleway to store a limitless volume of production data. The service is easily accessible and has numerous uses, such as for web and mobile applications, backing up and recovering business applications, and Big Data.

Object storage systems – which store data in an unstructured way and without any volume or time constraints – are now considered as a “must have” for developers in their panoply of infrastructure tools. Today’s developers are increasingly having to manage huge volumes of data, particularly for media files (videos, photos, etc.), and going forward this trend looks set to intensify even more. For example, IDC predicts that the Global Datasphere will grow from 33 zettabytes in 2018 to 175 by 2025, and that 49% of the world’s stored data will reside in public cloud environments\*.

It is against this backdrop that Scaleway has decided to launch its object storage solution, which is resolutely focused on speed, reliability and security. Scaleway’s servers are equipped with SSDs and NVMe SSDs that provide state-of-the-art performance, with access times of just a few milliseconds, and 99.999% guaranteed data integrity thanks to the replication mechanisms in its European data centers. Scaleway has also created a highly intuitive management console for this service, which can be used to very rapidly configure data confidentiality levels. Designed to be interoperable with most data storage tools, Scaleway’s solution is compatible with API S3, the benchmark standard for object storage.

Scaleway's billing structure is very straightforward, with a pack billed at €5/month for 500GB of storage and 500GB of outbound transfers. Any additional GB used is then billed at €0.01/month for storage and €0.02/month for outbound transfers. Transit to the Scaleway infrastructure is free in the region where the service has been launched, which allows for exchanges with the servers and instances. The Object Storage service is already available for users of the Scaleway data center in the Amsterdam region and it will very soon be rolled out to Scaleway's Paris data centers.

The launch of the Object Storage service is an important step in Scaleway's development as it is the first storage brick in its coherent and simplified cloud ecosystem. And so this Iliad Group cloud subsidiary – whose goal is to meet the innovation requirements of corporations and start-ups – is moving firmly along its roadmap.
