## Free expands its content line-up by adding seven more channels owned by the RMC BFM group



Free has included seven more RMC BFM group channels in its Freebox TV offer: *BFM Grands Reportages*, *RMC Talk Info*, *RMC WOW*, *RMC Mystère*, *RMC Alerte Secours*, *RMC Mecanic* and *RMC J'irai dormir chez vous*. Designed for all audiences interested in documentaries, entertainment, news and current affairs, these channels are available at no extra cost and join the 260 channels that already come with the Freebox plans (and over 300 in the Freebox Ultra Plan).

With the arrival of these seven new channels, as from today, Freebox subscribers have access to a unique range of content, including factual, adventure and entertainment shows, and categories like "News & Society" and "Mechanics":



**BFM Grands Reportages** (channel 162): a deep dive into the defining narratives of today's world, with the very best of BFMTV's investigative reporting and documentaries, such as *Jean-Jacques Goldman Confidentiel*, *En immersion dans une cité de la drogue*, *Dupont de Ligonnès: et s'il était toujours en vie?*, and many others.



**RMC Talk Info** (channel 169): insightful debates and bold, thought-provoking commentary on current affairs, with shows like *Les Grandes Gueules*, *Apolline Matin* and *Estelle Midi*.



**RMC WOW** (channel 222): the home of the spectacular and incredible; for extreme, out-of-the-ordinary, supercharged, hyper and mega moments. Get ready for XXL thrills, with shows such as *Les volcans les plus dangereux du monde*, *Les 10 catastrophes qui ont marqué la planète*, *Dans les secrets du Rafale* and *Les camions de l'extrême*.



**RMC Mystère** (channel 223): the channel dedicated to eye-opening content that lies at the boundaries of the mysterious, the paranormal and investigation. Covering topics from ancient Egyptian monuments and mystical artifacts to fantasy creatures, its programming includes shows such as *Phénomènes vus de l'espace*, *Pyramides, les mystères révélés*, and *Le secret des templiers*.



**RMC Alerte Secours** (channel 224): an immersive journey alongside emergency and security teams, providing an insight into their daily work surrounded by conflict, provocation, excess and drama, with shows including *100 jours avec la police* and *Enquête prioritaire - Maltraitance et secrets de famille*.



**RMC Mecanic** (channel 233): all about engines, mechanics, and the love of cars. Focused on speed, grease, iconic brands, restorations and dream cars, this channel offers the best of automotive shows, such as *Top Gear France*, *SOS Garage*, *Vintage Mecanic* and *Les Reines de la mécanique*.



**RMC J'irai dormir chez vous** (channel 251): the pure globetrotter channel that follows Antoine de Maximy's best journeys around the world, with ever-more incredible encounters. Just a few of the places featured are Algeria, India, Chile, Quebec, Romania and the Burning Man festival.

They're accessible directly via the mosaic viewing guide on channel 27, as well as through the OQEE by Free TV app. With this app, several members of the same family can watch the programs they want on different screens (Smart TV, tablet, phone, etc.) at the same time, at home or when they're on the move.
