

## Free includes 4G in its Free Mobile Plan

Free has once again enhanced its mobile offerings by including a **4G service** in its Free Mobile Plan (€19.99/month or €15.99/month for Freebox subscribers), at no extra cost and still on a no-commitment basis.


### Ever-faster bandwidths and the market's highest data volume (20GB via 4G) at the best price

Thanks to its network investments and acquisition of 4G frequencies, Free is one of the only two French operators to have 20 MHz dedicated to 4G services in the 2.6 GHz band.

This wide frequency band means that Free can currently offer its subscribers the fastest maximum theoretical speeds, of up to **150 Mbps\***.

So that subscribers can get the most out of 4G, Free also offers them the market's highest data volume (fair-use allowance), at **20GB via 4G** (with speeds slowed in excess of 20GB).

By including 4G in its Free Mobile Plan, Free Mobile is now offering a price that is five times cheaper\*\* than that proposed in the market for this type of 4G plan.

**The 4G service will be available at no extra cost** to all Free Mobile Plan subscribers (both existing and new) who have a 4G-compatible phone, once they have activated the 4G service in the subscriber area of the Free Mobile website.

## **A network in rollout phase**

Designed from the outset as an all-IP network (NGN) that can offer both 4G and 3G coverage, the Free network now has more than 700 4G sites covering over 1,000 towns and cities (as at December 1, 2013). This coverage is set to rapidly increase with several hundred new 4G sites coming on stream in the next few weeks.

It is important to note that a number of factors can impact 4G reception:

- how close the user is to a 4G site;
- the number of users connected to a 4G site at the same time;
- the existence of any obstacles to the signal (high buildings, hills/mountains, etc.);
- the capacity of the transmission network to which a 4G site is connected.

Free's mobile offerings include both telephone hotlines and in-store assistance (Free Centers).

*Free is the inventor of the Freebox, the first multiservice box on ADSL. Free is behind numerous innovations in the broadband access segment (VoIP, IPTV, flat-rate calling plans to multiple destinations, etc.). Free provides straightforward and innovative offerings at the best prices. At the end of 2010, Free introduced the Freebox Revolution, the 6th generation of Freebox units that notably includes an NAS and a Blu-Ray™ drive. Free was the first operator to include calls from landlines to mobile phones in its offerings and also calls to French overseas departments (DOM). Since January 2012, Free has brought mobile phone usage within everyone's reach with straightforward, no-commitment offerings at very attractive prices. Free has over 5.5 million broadband subscribers and more than 7.4 million mobile subscribers (as at September 30, 2013).*
