COVID-19: Free offers 20 times more 4G data to subscribers on its €0 and €2 mobile plans

As of today, the 5 million subscribers on Free Mobile's €0 and €2 mobile plans will have **1 GB of 4G data** instead of their usual 50 MB monthly allowance, **i.e. 20 times more data**, until the end of April.

This initiative applies to all our €0 and €2 plan subscribers and particularly schoolchildren and students, who make up a significant proportion of those subscribers.

The subscribers concerned will not have to carry out any formalities to get this higher data allowance, as the increase will be automatic, immediate, and at no extra cost.

In parallel, our teams are working flat out to ensure that Free's 20 million subscribers in France have the means of communication and Internet access they need.

Free – an Iliad Group subsidiary – is the inventor of the Freebox, the first multiservice box on ADSL. Free is behind numerous innovations in the Broadband and Ultra-Fast Broadband access segment. Since January 2012, Free has brought mobile phone usage within everyone's reach with straightforward offerings at very attractive prices. As at September 30, 2019, Free had nearly 20 million subscribers in France (6.4 million Broadband and Ultra-Fast Broadband subscribers and 13.3 million mobile subscribers). On May 29, 2018, the Group launched its mobile network in Italy under the Iliad brand, becoming the country's fourth operator, and had nearly 4.5 million subscribers at September 30, 2019.
